We dug up and fixed most of the leak on Tanglewood (close to Rosewood) Due to contractor unloading equipment there on our 6in main There is still a leak under the road that will need to be fixed waiting to meet With Allen since it will be across county road

We fixed a leak on Tanglewood and Highpoint due to someone running over a air release valve Will put in another air release valve and concrete barriers to help prevent this from happening again

We plumbed in the first part of the Bypass for plant one we just need about a day to finish the rest (we had a lot of jackhammering) Then tank will be ready for repair

We did 4 taps

And have 1 more to do

We fixed a leak on Eagle Rock do to roots wrapped around the pipe and old customer service line We cut out all the roots and replaced that piece of broken pipe

We dug 4 bore pits and exposed the existing water line on Tanglewood (between burning tree and Overbrook) for the some company to start

We replaced all valves on the pressure tanks and sight glasses due to leaks from the freeze

We did line locates for PEC

We are almost done with the GPS locations for the meters that we started that way y'all can have a map of all the meter locations that should be done by next month if everything works out as planned

We cleaned all trash and debris out of the plants

This next month we plan on finishing the 3 inch line upgrade on Tanglewood between burning tree and Overbrook

We plan on starting the line upgrade on winding Creek going towards Tanglewood from 2 inch to 6 inch

We plan on wiring up the MOVs at North and bobwhite station for a tank overflow

We plan on adding one more tee for north station to be able to bypass the tank if ever need be

And fixing the 6in valve on Bobwhite and Tanglewood
